Centerpoint Properties and ISI Communications Ink Deal

Centerpoint Properties Trust and ISI Communications have reached an agreement to provide advanced IP and data services at the DNTP, a technology park located in West Chicago.

Our goal is to build a TeraPOP of diverse carriers and networks that serve DNTP tenants and other broadband customers said Dan Howard, President of ISI Communications. We had the advantage of starting with a blank canvas to create a world class optical infrastructure that will serve today's most demanding communications requirements now and well into the future.

The company stated that the existing infrastructure will support 3.2 Terabits of data transmission (the equivalent of over 2 million T1s of bandwidth), with room to expand when needed. Additionally, the DNTP will play host to a new data peering service that provides data exchange services to telecommunications carriers, service providers, and content providers. iNAP, the data peering company, will offer services at the DNTP, and key carrier points of presence in the Chicago Metropolitan area. The iNAP is expected to compete with the Equinix IX services in Chicago, and rollout across the greater Central (non-coastal) United States, as a low cost, high availability alternative.
